The past four months have been an absolute privilege and I have been so honoured to serve as the Member of Parliament for Milton. There is no single issue that I heard about more than our unified opposition to CN's proposed Intermodal Facility in Milton.

A review panel has found that it will have significant adverse impacts on the environment as well. It will impact our health, safety and livelihoods.

I was clear at your doorstep, and I have also been clear to my colleagues in Ottawa that there is no support for the selected location for the CN Intermodal here in Milton.

Since being elected, I have taken many actions to make Milton's voice heard in Ottawa. I have had meetings with the Minister of Transport and the Minister of the Environment and Climate Change, as well as other cabinet members, highlighting the disastrous impact the project would have in our riding. I did a presentation speaking on this issue for my fellow Members of Parliament.

Additionally, I have met with CN where I amplified your voices and the thousands I have heard at the door. The people of Milton are against the proposed site for the CN intermodal because of the negative effects it would have on our community.

I will continue working with my colleagues, citizen action groups, local politicians and the people of the Halton region on this issue. However, I need to hear from you, I will be hosting a Town Hall on Saturday March 28th at 3PM, at Craig Kielburger Secondary School in partnership with Halton Region.

Lets send a message that we are unified in opposition to this location by showing up in large numbers. Please join us to make sure your voice is heard.
